COKEVILLE, Wyo.—Kenneth H. Dimick, 67, died Tuesday at the Montpelier hospital of an apparent heart attack.

He was born Jan. 20, 1910, at Wardboro to Francis Alma and Alice Evans Dimick. He married Mildred Brooks Sept. 16, 1939, at Randolph, Utah. He was a member of the LDS Church and worked many years as a heavy equipment operator for Stauffer Chemical Co., retiring in 1975. He served in World War II in both the European and Pacific theatres.
