

OLD PIONEER WOMAN TAKEN

MRS. ORPHA GAGE DIES AT
HOME OF DAUGHTER
EARLY TODAY.

Mrs. Orpha A. Gage, mother of Mrs. Edward Kneal, passed away this morning at 9:45 o'clock after an extended illness. She was 84 years old.

Mrs. Gage was born at Yates, New York, April 16, 1842, and was married to Mr. Gage December 20, 1865, at her home city. Mr. and Mrs. Gage came to Petoskey 39 years ago and located on a farm east of the city. Mr. Gage passed away twenty-six years ago last November.

Mrs. Gage was a member of the First Methodist church of this city.

Surviving are two children, a son, Adin, of Tensed, Idaho, and the daughter, Mrs. Edward Kneal, of Petoskey. Four sisters and two brothers also survive. They are Mrs. Nora Eastman, Los Angeles; Mrs. George Wallace, Lindenville, New York; Mrs. Emma Pierce and Mrs. Arthur Lewis, Middleport, New York; Edward Coon and George Coon, of Lindenville, New York.
