MINEOLA, L. I., Feb. 29.—The will of Edward M. Townsend, a resident of Oyster Bay, L. I., and a friend of the President, was filed this afternoon in the Nassau County Surrogate's Court. With the exception of his home in Oyster Bay, which he leaves to his son Edward M., Jr., he divides the entire estate among the children. No amount is given, but it is thought to be worth fully \$1,000,000.
